Seahorses mate for life and don't take new partners when one of them dies. They are no ordinary creatures. Apart from their monogamy, which is highly unusual in the animal kingdom, it is the male who receives eggs from his female partner and fertilizes them himself. He then carries them for about three weeks before giving birth to as many as two hundred offspring at a time.

An estimated 40 million wild seahorses are caught each year for the traditional Chinese medicine market where they are used to treat a range of ailment, including heart disease. Demand has increased so much in recent times that they now cost as much as US\$1,900 a kilo in Asia, but the species is on the point of extinction because of over-fishing. Consequently, in 2004, a ban on international trade in seahorses, unless they are bred in captivity, is due to come into effect. This will affect the livelihoods of thousands of fishermen and probably encourage a flourishing trade on the black market.
