# Forgers make Japan wary of taking yen at face value [Taiwan News 2005/2/22/]

- 1. Being handed a big banknote is often an anxious moment for taxi driver Mitsuo Nomura as he checks whether he has enough change.
- 2. But after a recent rash of forgery discoveries in Japan, he now must also make sure the cash is real.
- 3. "I don't like holding up a bill to check because customers are in a hurry and it's very rude, as if I don't trust them," he said. "But we have to be careful, with so many cases lately."

- **6.** Fake banknotes are also turning up. Some 30,000 forged bills are estimated to have been found last year, almost double the amount found in the previous year, and officials say the frequency of such cases has risen in the past few months.
- 7. "We must let it be known that currency counterfeiting is a very serious crime," a Finance Ministry official told reporters.

  "This cannot be condoned and we are looking at methods to prevent such incidents, and are working with various authorities."
- **8.** The popularity of cash transactions in Japan compared with other industrial countries makes businesses all the more vulnerable, although credit card and bank card theft are also on the rise.
- **9.** The incidents follow the introduction of harder-to-forge 1,000,5,000 and 10,000 yen bills last October in the first major overhaul in 20 years.
