III. Reading Comprehension (20%)

Many ancient people had different forms of writing. Later people studied these old written records to learn about lost ways of life. By the late 1700s, they had learned much about early people and events. But early Egyptian history remained locked in mystery. No one could read the early Egyptian form of writing. It was made up of small pictures. This language was a riddle that no one had solved.

In 1799 Napoleon led his French troops near Rosetta, Egypt. There some of his men found a stone half buried in the mud. The stone was made of black rock. Its flat surface was covered with writing. The writing was divided into three sections. Two parts had Greek words. One part had Egyptian pictures. The pictures were from the ancient language. Experts came from far and near to see the Rosetta stone.

The experts guessed that each part of the stone said the same thing. They could read the Greek words, but they could not read the Egyptian picture writing. They hoped that the Greek words would give clues about the Egyptian writing. But no one could break the code.

Years passed, and still no one could tell what the pictures meant. Then in 1818 Jean Francois Champollion studied stone. He looked at proper names in the Greek writing and found the same names in Egyptian picture writing. He figured out that some pictures in Egyptian writing stood for sounds. He worked for several more years to solve the mystery. When he finished, he could read the Rosetta stone. In 1822, he wrote a small book about the code. Other people studied his book. Then they could read other writings of ancient Egypt.
